HOW? Technical Requirements



- **Sound System:** A speaker or sound system is needed for music playback. I bring the music on my phone and only need a Bluetooth connection or USB-C input.
- **Microphone** (Optional): A wireless headset mic is ideal for larger groups or noisy environments. A handheld microphone also works.
- **Floor Type** (Flexible): Smooth surfaces such as wood, parquet or polished concrete are ideal, but not required. The workshop can adapt to different terrains, even bare soil.
